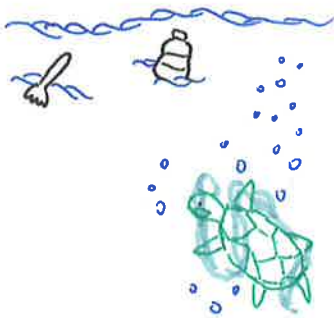


Loving the environment

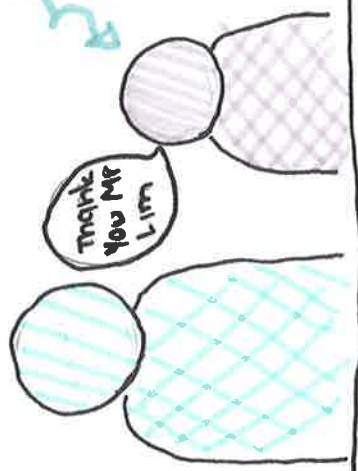

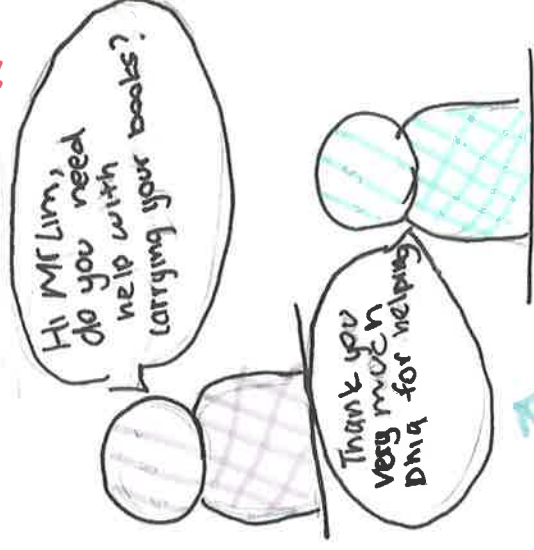
